Pam Rutherford, President:

*Pam explained that the General Meetings are held monthly on the first Tuesday of each month on the Irons Club Patio. As a member it is important to attend to keep current on club events and changes that may occur. Raffle tickets will be given to all members who attend.

*This year we are having Shot Gun starts on Tuesday, Women's day. This was mandated by Tom, but we are happy to implement the shot gun starts since we feel that it enhances the camaraderie of our Women's Club.

*This year Coral Mountain Golf Club will be enforcing a 72 hour cancellation policy.

*Pam informed us that we will be extending our Tuesday Sweeps through May this season since many members wanted to continue playing organized games on Tuesdays.

*The Board wants to hear from members about changes they want. As a result of member suggestions, we have made many of the changes that are being implemented this year: shot gun starts, guest days, continuing sweeps through May, summer golf thoughts, combining a tournament, more mixing of Rats and Birds in sweeps, trying out playing from multiple T-boxes (happening on 3/24). Pam reminded the members that this is your club. She suggested that our motto for this year should be, "I can make a difference."

Board Member Reports:

*We are going to have another Friendship Tournament with the Nine-Holers. It will be held on January 21, 2020. We will have our usual sweeps play in the morning, but in the afternoon we will have a 9 hole tournament with a game with both clubs. It will be followed by a Happy Hour.

*Our budget year has been changed to match our golf season. It will now run from May 1 through April 30.
