*Melissa discussed the major changes that will be taking place in the handicapping system beginning in January. It will become a World-Wide Handicapping System.

*From Jan. 1-Jan. 5 no posting will be possible due the system's being up-loaded. After that members MUST post scores every day that they play, since handicaps will be adjusted on a daily bases.

*After the new system is in place most people will find that their handicaps have dropped by a few strokes. This is due to the new calculation that will be used to determine handicaps.

*Players' course handicaps will automatically adjust based upon what t-box they play.

*Starting in January, the Women's Club will use Thursday's handicaps for the following Tuesday's sweeps. An updated handicap report will be posted each Thursday on the website.
